Perhaps the best known Champagne, the Brut Impérial from Moët et Chandon embodies their house style: crisp and clean. This classic Champagne shows citrus aromas and hints of biscuity flavours.

Moët et Chandon Rosé Impérial N.V. | France £15.00 £77.50

Seductive Champagne with an elegant mousse and lively aromas of wild strawberries, the flavour is packed with full-bodied summer fruits.

Veuve Clicquot Brut N.V. | France £15.00 £75.00 £150.00

Fruity and full-bodied; refined and well-balanced, with crisp, fresh flavours, a touch of spice and a lingering finish.

Chenin Blanc, Veldt Range 2018 | South Africa £7.50 £28.50

A really well-balanced wine. The aromas are reminiscent of melon and lychees, with soft, tropical fruit flavours dominating the palate followed by an elegant, refreshing acidity on the finish.

Mâcon Blanc Villages, Joseph Drouhin 2015 | France £8.95 £36.00

Pale straw in colour, exhibiting classic white Burgundy aromas of butter and bread, with rich Chardonnay fruit on the palate.

Pinot Grigio, Castelforte 2017 | Italy £7.95 £32.50

Dry and fruity, with intense, citrus scents of grapefruit and pleasant, herbal notes of sage.

Sauvignon Blanc, Jackson Estate 2016 | New Zealand £8.45 £34.00

Outstanding Sauvignon Blanc from the Marlborough region in the South Island. Tropical fruits, balanced with fine minerality and good acidity, followed by a long, expressive finish.

Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Bonnard 2017 | France £38.50

Delicious and expressive, combining the best Loire Valley Sauvignon Blanc with a hint of the New Zealand style. Look for the lime zest, cut grass and a touch of fresh flowers.

Chardonnay, Rodney Strong 2015 | USA £45.00

Floral honeysuckle, ripe fig and melon scents are rich, full-bodied, elegant and refined, showing a light touch of toasty vanilla oak on the finish.

Pouilly-Fumé, Patrice Moreux 2016 | France £62.45

Wonderful concentration of fresh gooseberry and cut grass aromas, with a classic, smoky, apple tart nose, a nice, full palate and good balance. This wine is wonderful with just about any dish.

Meursault, Maison Joseph Drouhin 2016 | France £92.45

A beautiful golden colour and a great aromatic palate of honey, linden flower and hazelnut butter, sometimes even chamomile or hawthorn. A wonderful, silky roundness on the palate.

Red Wine

Beaujolais Villages, Joseph Drouhin 2013 | France £8.45 £34.00

The wine has a bright purple colour, a very intense nose, reminiscent of violets, peonies and red berries. On the palate, it has a velvety smoothness and its delicious fruit lingers for a long time.

Malbec, Montañés 2017 | Argentina £8.00 £32.00

Red-ruby colour with violet hints. Raspberry and spices on the nose. A modern, fruit-forward style of Malbec, with subtle oak influence, giving lovely, sweet, spicy notes.

Merlot, La Poderosa 2017 | Chile £7.50 £28.50

Fruit-driven Merlot, silky-smooth and easy-drinking.

Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Beronia 2016 | Spain £8.45 £34.00

Garnet in colour, with strawberry and blackberry aromas. Smooth and silky on the palate with fresh cherry fruit, chocolate and coffee flavours.

Côtes du Rhône, Parcelles 38, Jérôme Quiot 2015 | France £35.50

A blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre, this is a serious Côtes du Rhône, full-flavoured with the structure to support the ample fruit.

Syrah, Lomond Estate 2014 | South Africa £40.50

Notes of white pepper, with hints of wood spice and berry following through on the palate. A beautifully integrated and elegant wine with supple, soft tannins.

Pinot Noir, Amisfield 2015 | New Zealand £67.50

Beautifully aromatic with complex cherries, raspberries and fine oak. The palate is taut, spicy, yet silky and fruit-driven, with a delicate finish.

Amarone della Valpolicella, Zenato 2013 | Italy £97.50

This wine is of limited production, obtained from specially selected grapes where the bunches are picked and left to partially dry on wooden frames. It is a dry, generous wine, with an intense aroma and a harmonious, soft flavour. Aged for three years in oak barrels.

Cheval des Andes 2013 | Argentina £195.00

This collaborative effort of the esteemed Château Cheval Blanc and Terrazas de Los Andes would see a seamless fusion of the very best of French savoir faire, with the very best high-altitude terroirs of Argentina, a union of old and new worlds that would lead to a single, extraordinary wine. It displays an intense red colour with purple reflections in the glass. On the nose, this wine is very subtle, yet precise, offering fresh aromas of violet and pepper along with warm, ripe fruits, including raspberry and black fruits. It is very full in body, with concentrated flavours and a very fine tannic structure. The finish of this wine is tense, with a gorgeous acidity and freshness at the very end.

Scottish Beer

WEST Brewery

WEST's quirky wee brewery in the iconic Templeton Building is well-known in Glasgow, having brewed the city's favourite WEST beers since 2006. WEST is the only UK brewery to produce all of its artisan beers in strict accordance with the Reinheitsgebot, the German Purity Law of 1516 — using only barley, hops, water and yeast in production.

WEST GPA..... 330ml £5.00

Like IPAs and their American counterparts, our GPA (German Pale Ale) is light with a hoppy finish. It is made with both malted barley and wheat and is strongly hopped with American Chinook and Hallertau Mittelfrueh hops, which perfectly complement its dry, biscuity finish.

WEST St Mungo 330ml £4.80

Named after the patron saint of Glasgow and fellow brewer, this is our flagship Premium Lager. St Mungo is a traditional Bavarian 'Helles' lager, which makes for a complex, yet very drinkable beer. Its natural carbonation and firm, crisp taste perfectly counters its malty body.

Harviestoun Brewery

Six miles east of historic Stirling, the village of Alva, nestling at the foot of the beautiful Ochil Hills (a walking mecca), plays host to one of the world's most renowned breweries — Harviestoun. From humble beginnings in founder Ken Brooker's kitchen, through corporate ownership and back to independence, Harviestoun remains among the true elite in the craft brewing world.

Harviestoun Bitter & Twisted 500ml £5.50

Bitter and Twisted was allegedly named after our brewer's wife. A refreshingly lively blonde beer with a tingly, lemony finish, it goes down a whole lot better than his little joke did.

Harviestoun Broken Dial 330ml £5.00

This gloriously amber coloured ale is made with what is often considered to be the finest hop on earth, namely the Simcoe Hop. The result is a fantastically fruity finish with distinctly malty undertones.

Harviestoun Schiehallion..... 500ml £5.50

The perfectly-paired combination of wheat malt and lager malt is our secret sauce for this 'Champagne of Lagers', providing an elegant head, luscious lacing and crisp palate.

Cognac & Port

Rémy Martin

This established Cognac house has been around since 1724, producing exquisite Fine Champagne Cognac for nearly 300 years, which is the category of highest quality in Cognac production.

VSOP 25ml £5.50

55% Grande Champagne eaux-de-vie, with the rest being made up from Petite Champagne. The nose is sweet, with honey and vanilla, floral notes and chewy oak. The palate is spicy, with nectarine, dried apricot and plum.

1738 Accord Royale 25ml £7.80

Generous notes of plum and fig marmalade, rounded out by intense, oaky notes of toffee and toasted bread. The mellowness of butterscotch; baked spices with hints of dark chocolate. Exceptionally round, with a creamy aftertaste and a concentration of nutty aromas imparted by a careful blend of eaux-de-vie, aged in toasted French oak casks.

XO 25ml £21.45

A fine Champagne Cognac with 85% Grande Champagne and 15% Petite Champagne. The nose is fruity with dates, honey and warm pastries. Remarkably smooth, rich and mellow.

Maison Hennessy

Fine de Cognac 25ml £7.00

Different to many traditional styles of Cognac, this delicate blend of some sixty fruity and floral eaux-de-vie is the perfect combination of elegance and harmony. This finely balanced composition reveals subtle aromas of orange flower, lemon, cinnamon and honey, before giving way to light touches of spices, pine forest and honey. The finish has light, oaky notes.

Bartender's Choice

Our expert bar team's personal recommendations.

Auchentoshan Three Wood 25ml £8.00

Hailing from the Auchentoshan distillery, located just across the valley in Clydebank. Matured initially in Bourbon casks, before being finished in Oloroso then Pedro Ximénez casks for an extra layer of fruitiness.

Bowmore 15 YO 25ml £9.25

A Whisky coming into its prime. This 15-year-old Single Malt, which spends its final three years in Oloroso Sherry casks, is elegantly balanced between this Sherry influence.

Bruichladdich Octomore 8.4 25ml £15.95

Bruichladdich Octomore is known for experimental releases and the most heavily peated Whisky selection in the world. 8.4 of Octomore's masterclass series is made using Scottish barley and is peated to 167ppm.

Bunnahabhain 12 YO 25ml £6.50

Lightly peated for an Islay Single Malt and consequently is a light, fresh dram. Sherried, mochaccino, herbal notes, balanced with a salty tang.

Glenfarclas 105 Cask Strength 25ml £8.00

Powerful and Sherry notes on the nose, the sweetness contrasts the subtle burnt coffee tones. Smooth and spicy to taste, nuts and thick sweetness on the tongue with a long and peppery finish.

Glenfiddich 21 YO Gran Reserva 25ml £18.00

The award winning Glenfiddich 21 year old has been aged in casks that once contained premium Caribbean Rum — and these are used to finish this 21 Year Old expression.

Glenmorangie Signet 25ml £23.00

Created with a marriage of Whiskies produced from two unique types of malted barley, one of which is a malted chocolate barley, better known as a basis for craft beers.

Highland Park Dark 17 YO 25ml £16.00

The Dark is a 17 year old Single Malt, which has been drawn from European oak Sherry-seasoned casks. A fantastic example of how blending Sherried richness with elegant smoky elements can work spectacularly.

Johnnie Walker 18 YO Platinum Label 25ml £11.00

Stewed fruit, malty cereal, smooth creamy vanilla, fragrant almonds and tangerines give Johnnie Walker Platinum Label its waxy, fruity and sweet taste, mixed with slight drying astringency with subtle smokiness.

Macallan Rare Cask 25ml £25.00

Macallan Rare Cask is comprised of 16 different Sherry-cask styles, the majority of which are first fill. Rich and complex, with notes of dark honey and dried fruit

Hennessy Paradis Impérial

Hennessy Paradis Impérial embodies the pinnacle of the art of selection. From any harvest, the average number of eaux-de-vie with the potential to join this blend are a rare few.

The Master Blender defines the right aging conditions to raise a fine eau-de-vie to its point of elegance: the decisive and fleeting moment when the eau-de-vie reaches its full potential, ready to join the Hennessy Paradis Impérial blend.

Character

The unprecedented alliance of age and finesse, Paradis Impérial is a Cognac of magisterial complexity, balance and the finest texture, continually revealing new tones of expression and delicate floral essences on the palate.

Macallan Reflexion



Part of The Macallan Masters Decanter Series created to showcase the beautiful range of The Macallan's natural colour, Reflexion embodies the foremost influence of first-fill Sherry-seasoned oak casks.

Character

This exceptional Single Malt draws its colour and flavour from maturation in smaller hogshead casks, allowing a greater surface area of wood to interact with the Whisky, to deliver an intricate character influenced by both Spanish and American oak casks. The depth of colour and complex flavour of Reflexion is derived from the use of first-fill casks, carefully selected for this distinctive expression to accentuate its aromas and flavours. Bold and full-bodied, Reflexion is a celebration of floral and vanilla notes, punctuated with fresh apples and apricots.

Initial light citrus zest with new oak gives way to the succulent sweetness of lemon and orange. Raisin, sultana and apple, with a hint of cinnamon and ginger.

Rémy Martin Louis XIII

A truly stunning Cognac from Rémy Martin. It is blended from around 1,200 different eaux-de-vie from the Grande Champagne appellation, and some of the spirit was distilled more than 100 years ago.

Character

Over the decades, a mysterious communion between the air, the wood and the eaux-de-vie culminates in a magical firework of flavours and aromas, evoking myrrh, honey, dried roses, plum, honeysuckle, cigar box, leather, figs and passionfruit. Louis XIII develops intense aromas which persist more than one hour on the palate. The myriad of reflections and colours dancing in the light ranges from assertive and flamboyant golden hues to marvellous reflections of mahogany, all the way up to fiery red. “LOUIS XIII is a wave of sensations that carries you away” says Cellar Master Baptiste Loiseau.

Glenfarclas 40yo



Glenfarclas' stunning 40 year old Whisky launched during the Spirit of Speyside Whisky Festival 2010. It offers all of the Sherried Glenfarclas character and exceptional maturity too.

Character

Very complex and rich. Calves leather, cedar wood cigar boxes and cocoa kicking things off. Then we're onto waves of sweet Sherry, chocolate orange, marmalade and butterscotch. Hints of molasses develop with just a whisper of pepper.

About as rich and intense as anything from Glenfarclas. The chocolate richness develops in the glass, with notes of chocolate raisins, dates and figs, orange and maraschino cherry. Then spices and thick espresso coffee.

Sublimely concentrated waves of mochaccino and gingerbread, with deep leathery notes clinging to the end.
